• The Classic Slash: This is the basic version, with the raw edges of the cut reinforced with stitching or binding for a clean look.

This is a type of slash pocket. In this case, a wider strip of fabric (the welt) is sewn around the slash opening, creating a more defined and elevated finish.

#5 Flap Pockets


